Romans 6:2


We died to sin; how can we live in it any longer? Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death Romans 6:3-4


The believer is united with the Messiah In his death



in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. Romans 6:3-4

The believer is united with the Messiah In his resurrection





If we have been united with him like this in his death, we will certainly also be united with him in his resurrection Romans 6:5


You're joined to Jesus

AND


In his resurrection





For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin-- because anyone who has died has been freed from sin. Romans 6:6

You died to sin



Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; **death no longer has mastery over him**. The death he died, he died to sin once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God.



Jesus defeated death

Do not offer the parts of your body to sin, as instruments(weapons) of wickedness, but rather offer yourselves to God, as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer the parts of your body to him as instruments of righteousness. Romans 6:13



For sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law, but under grace. Romans 6:14



THE BIG PRINCIPLE

(The most misunderstood one)

You are not under law (subject to its penalties) but under grace (subject to grace's enabling)

What then? Shall we sin because we are not under the law but under grace? By no means! Romans 6:15




Don't you know that when you offer yourselves to someone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one you obey--whether you are slaves to sin, which leads to death,?







For the wages of sin is death, but the **gift of God** is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:23


