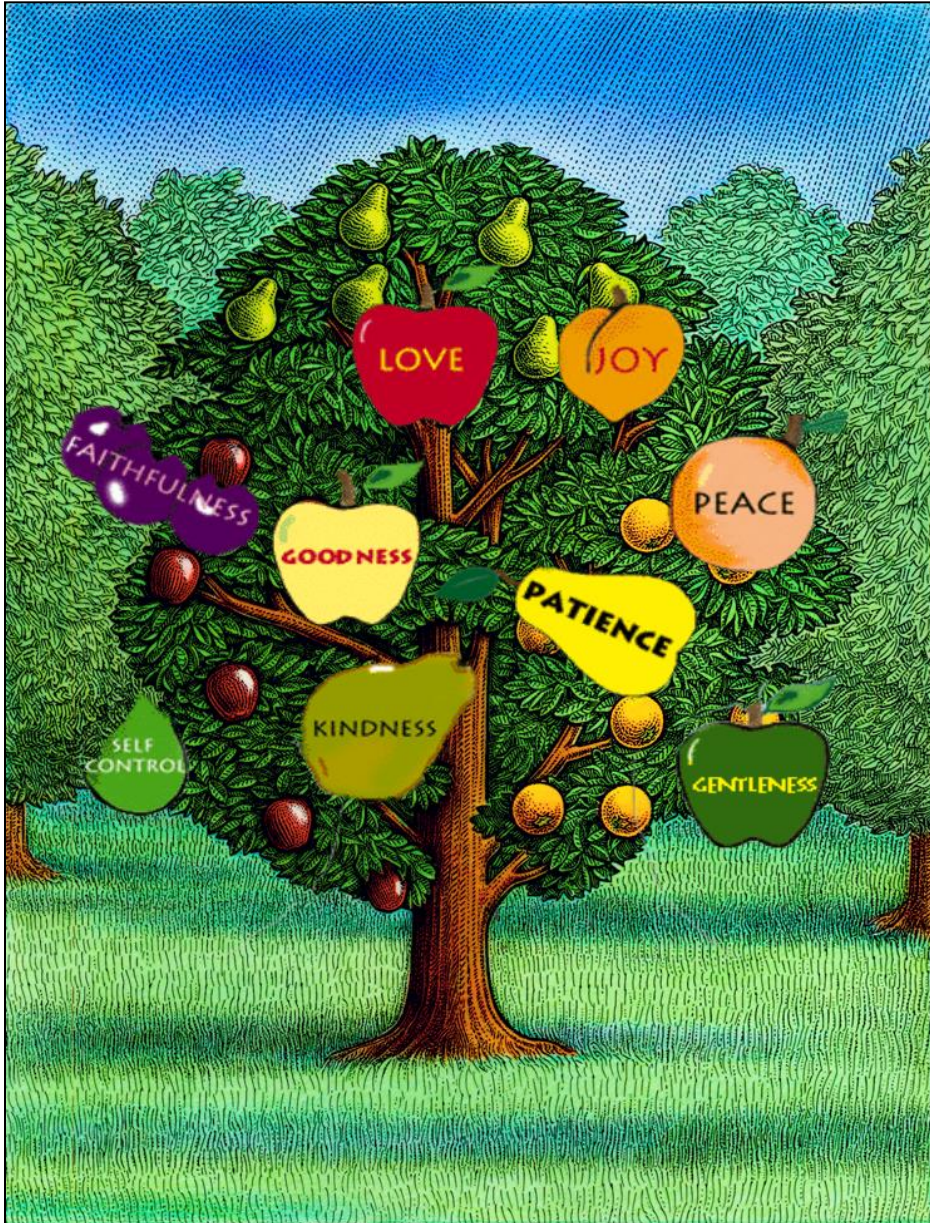

John 15:5 - 8



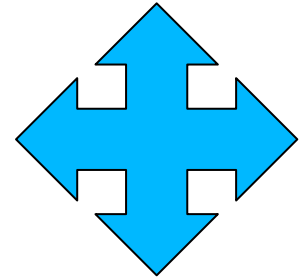
