

Patience


Forbearance

Long-suffering

OT equivalent = slow to anger



God's patience = slow to anger (this is an attribute of God)



And the Lord passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, Exodus 34:6

God's patience: one of the reasons why he shows it




Bear in mind that our Lord's patience means salvation,
2 Peter 3:15

Or do you show contempt for the riches of his kindness, forbearance and patience, not realizing that God's kindness is intended to lead you to repentance? Romans 2:4

The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.


