


Genesis 1 "God"

## Beautiful and Useful






In the middle of the garden were the tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

### A river watering the garden flowed from Eden


#### The Head source

### Man needs more than a pet!







The perfect match – God made





### **Jesus endorses Genesis 2**



Matthew 19: 4 - 6




### Adam and his wife were both naked,
