


After the flood there must have been some major changes to the earth's atmosphere

These have their origins in Genesis 8 and 9






Saved!

Here we see substitution is God's way of salvation


The LORD smelled the pleasing aroma and said in his heart:

Why did God give permission for man to eat meat?

Diet requirements (in some parts of new world – insufficient vegetation ?)

Genetic information loss – vitamin/ mineral requirements more exacting? Cf. vitamin C B12 for Vegan diet

Genesis 9: 3



The place of blood as representation of life, and its place in sacrifice.

Possibly also to prevent cruelty to the animals

And for your lifeblood I will surely demand an accounting.

I will demand an accounting from every animal.

And from each human being, too,

I will demand an accounting for the life of another human being.

Genesis 9: 5



for in the image of God has God made mankind.

I will demand an accounting for the life of another human being. Whoever sheds human blood, by humans shall their blood be shed; for in the image of God has God made mankind.

Genesis 9: 6



Government / rule of law given to man by God Cf. Romans 13: 1- 4 (It can be abused by leaders but) The Bible distinguishes – manslaughter – murder

As for you, be fruitful and increase in number; multiply on the earth and increase upon it. Genesis 9: 7



3rd part of the covenant – renewal of Genesis 1: 28

Then God said to Noah and to his sons with him: "I now establish my covenant with you and with your descendants after you and with every living creature that was with you--the birds, the livestock and all the wild animals, all those that came out of the ark with you--every living creature on earth."

Genesis 9: 8



I establish my covenant with you:

Never again will all life be destroyed by the waters of a flood; never again will there be a flood to destroy the earth.

Genesis 9: 11

It's a promise

"YOU CAN DEPEND ON GOD"



And God said, "This is the sign of the covenant I am making between me and you and every living creature with you, a covenant for all generations to come:

I have set my rainbow in the clouds, and it will be the sign of the covenant between me and the earth." Genesis 9: 12 ...



Whenever the rainbow appears in the clouds, I will see it and remember the everlasting covenant between God and all living creatures of every kind on the earth."

So God said to Noah, "This is the sign of the covenant I have established between me and all life on the earth."
