Bera Birsha Shinab Shemeber The king of Bela








For twelve years they had been subject to Kedorlaomer, but in the thirteenth year they rebelled.





We'll show them who's boss






Then the king of Sodom, the king of Gomorrah, the king of Admah, the king of Zeboyim and the king of Bela (that is, Zoar) marched out and drew up their battle lines in the Valley of Siddim against Kedorlaomer king of Elam, Tidal king of Goyim, Amraphel king of Shinar and Arioch king of Ellasar--four kings against five.



Now the Valley of Siddim was full of tar pits, and when the kings of Sodom and Gomorrah fled, some of the men fell into them and the rest fled to the hills.




It's a warning !

A man who had escaped came and reported this to Abram the Hebrew.






Getting on with the neighbours


When Abram heard that his relative had been taken captive, he called out the 318 trained men born in his household and went in pursuit as far as Dan.




There are some things that you have to fight for.



During the night Abram divided his men to attack them and he routed them, pursuing them as far as Hobah, north of Damascus.




He recovered all the goods and brought back his relative Lot and his possessions, together with the women and the other people.

He was priest of God Most High,


Who was Melchizedek ?

He was priest of God Most High, and he blessed Abram,




Abram's humility The designated "King" of the land !

Then Abram gave him a tenth of everything.




What did Abram give ?

Philippians 2:3-11 Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.
