Why is jealousy a sin?




Is it Jacob's fault?

Then Rachel said, "God has vindicated me; he has listened to my plea and given me a son."






God **listened** to Leah, and she became pregnant and bore Jacob a fifth son.

The danger of reading into things


Leah conceived again and bore Jacob a sixth son. Then Leah said, "God has presented me with a precious gift. Genesis 30:19
