

**Genesis Chapter 40** 


Some time later, the cupbearer and the baker of the king of Egypt offended their master, the king of Egypt. v1

Pharaoh was angry with his two officials, the chief cupbearer and the chief baker, and put them in custody in the house of the captain of the guard,




Pharaoh put them in custody in the "posh prison"

"attended"! What was Joseph's job?




Joseph gains their trust It takes time and wisdom




#### So what is special about these dreams?




Acts 2, Joel

When Joseph came to them the next morning, he saw that they were dejected.



So he asked Pharaoh's officials who were in custody with him in his master's house, "Why are your faces so sad today?" v7

his master = Potiphar




He noticed.

"We both had dreams," they answered, "but there is no one to interpret them."






**Give glory to God** 



Confident of God's help = faith

So the chief cupbearer told Joseph his dream. He said to him, "In my dream I saw a vine in front of me, and on the vine were three branches. As soon as it budded, it blossomed, and its clusters ripened into grapes. Pharaoh's cup was in my hand, and I took the grapes, squeezed them into Pharaoh's cup and put the cup in his hand."



"This is what it means," Joseph said to him. "The three branches are three days. Within three days Pharaoh will lift up your head and restore you to your position, and you will put Pharaoh's cup in his hand, just as you used to do when you were his cupbearer.

How did he know it meant three days?




It looks like a heaven-sent chance to get out with a bit of engineering

On my head were three baskets of bread. In the top basket were all kinds of baked goods for Pharaoh, but the birds were eating them out of the basket on my head."



Just as well the butler spoke first! A prophet's job is to tell it as it is.




He lifted up the heads of the chief cupbearer and the chief baker in the presence of his officials.. v20




the day of reckoning -


The chief cupbearer, however, did not remember Joseph; he forgot him. v23

# We don't have all the pieces and not much idea about the whole picture




### God is big enough to say no, or not yet
