


Why did he want all the attendants to leave?

And he wept so loudly that the Egyptians heard him,




Bottled up emotion released

and Pharaoh's household heard about it.




Joseph said to his brothers, "I am Joseph! Is my father still living?"



They had already told him – He is overcome – "Just say it one more time."


But his brothers were not able to answer him, because they were terrified at his presence.

When Jesus reveals himself. Zechariah 12:10-14


Then Joseph said to his brothers, "Come close to me." When they had done so, he said, "I am your brother Joseph, the one you sold into Egypt!




Come close! (Don't be afraid)

For how long? What about the prophecy (Genesis 15:13)?




Protection from assimilation and room to grow as a nation


Joseph's intention


They need convincing that it's true.

Condemned criminal to embraced brother!


And he kissed all his brothers and wept over them. Afterward his brothers talked with him.



Forgiven, embraced - phew!


Catch up time!

When the news reached Pharaoh's palace that Joseph's brothers had come, Pharaoh and all his officials were pleased.




A kind hearted Pharaoh


Pharaoh's instruction = Joseph's advice ?

Joseph gave them carts, as Pharaoh had commanded, and he also gave them provisions for their journey.




A seriously impressive wagon train!

To each of them he gave new clothing, but to Benjamin he gave three hundred shekels of silver and five sets of clothes.




Safe to bless his "special" brother now?

And this is what he sent to his father.. ten donkeys loaded with the best things of Egypt, and ten female donkeys loaded with grain and bread and other provisions for his journey.




And a big blessing for dad

The past stirred up— what do they say to dad?






It's unbelievable good news

They tell him what Joseph said and show him the blessing!






Israel (not Jacob) now speaking - I believe! (Romans 8:28)
