


Jacob's family goes to Egypt

So Israel set out with all that was his, and when he reached Beersheba, he offered sacrifices to the God of his father Isaac.






Why did he stop there?

And God spoke to Israel in a vision at night




Each word is special!

"Here I am," he replied. "I am God, the God of your father," he said.




"Can you remember what I said to him?"

"Do not be afraid to go down to Egypt, for I will make you into a great nation there. I will go down to Egypt with you, and I will surely bring you back again.




Do you think he was worried about leaving Canaan?


Then Jacob left Beersheba, and Israel's sons took their father Jacob and their children and their wives in the carts that Pharaoh had sent to transport him.




They also took with them their livestock and the possessions they had acquired in Canaan, and Jacob and all his offspring went to Egypt.



He took with him to Egypt his sons and grandsons and his daughters and granddaughters--all his offspring.



These are the names of the sons of Israel (Jacob and his descendants) who went to Egypt..



Reuben the firstborn of Jacob. The sons of **Reuben** - Hanoch, Pallu, Hezron and Carmi. The sons of **Simeon** - Jemuel, Jamin, Ohad, Jakin, Zohar and Shaul the son of a Canaanite woman. The sons of Levi - Gershon, Kohath and Merari. The sons of Judah - Er, Onan, Shelah, Perez and Zerah (but Er and Onan had died in the land of Canaan). The sons of Perez - Hezron and Hamul. The sons of Issachar - Tola, Puah, Jashub and Shimron. The sons of Zebulun - Sered, Elon and Jahleel. These were the sons Leah bore to Jacob in Paddan Aram, besides his daughter Dinah. These sons and daughters of his were thirty-three in all.

The sons of Gad - Zephon, Haggi, Shuni, Ezbon, Eri, Arodi and Areli. The sons of Asher - Imnah, Ishvah, Ishvi and Beriah. **Their sister was Serah.** The sons of Beriah - Heber and Malkiel. These were the children born to Jacob by Zilpah, whom Laban had given to his daughter Leah--**sixteen** in all.

The sons of Jacob's wife Rachel - Joseph and Benjamin. In Egypt, Manasseh and Ephraim were born to **Joseph** by Asenath daughter of Potiphera, priest of On. The sons of **Benjamin -** Bela, Beker, Ashbel, Gera, Naaman, Ehi, Rosh, Muppim, Huppim and Ard. These were the sons of Rachel who were born to Jacob - **fourteen** in all.

This number also includes Joseph who was in Egypt already




The son of **Dan** - Hushim. The sons of **Naphtali** - Jahziel, Guni, Jezer and Shillem. These were the sons born to Jacob by Bilhah, whom Laban had given to his daughter Rachel--**seven** in all.

All those who went to Egypt with Jacob--those who were his direct descendants, **not counting his sons` wives**--numbered sixty-six persons (+Jacob, Joseph). With the two sons who had been born to Joseph in Egypt, the members of Jacob`s family, which went to Egypt, were seventy in all.

Joseph is counted as 'coming' but is there already.


It seems Moses is giving us the completed list of Jacob's family that has all the ancestors of the tribal families.

Now Jacob sent Judah ahead of him to Joseph to get directions to Goshen.




He is now acting as the family leader.

Israel said to Joseph, "Now I am ready to die, since I have seen for myself that you are still alive."




