


PROPHETIC POETRY


The consequences of sin


The Terrible DUO - cruel to men and animals


Simeon was absorbed into Judah

(note the poetic parallels)








Judah's area was suitable for vine and flocks.

This name is not an insult!








Gad will be attacked by a band of raiders, but he will attack them at their heels.


The original language sounds like "a press presses him, but he presses the heel".




Asher's food will be rich; he will provide delicacies fit for a king.

Naphtali is a doe set free that bears beautiful fawns(sayings).



Eg. His brothers, Potiphar etc. as well as future battles to be won



An abundance of blessing


Benjamin is a ravenous wolf; in the morning he devours the prey, in the evening he divides the plunder.
