

What is it like over there? Joshua Chapter 2




Then Joshua son of Nun **secretly** sent two spies from Shittim (Acacia Grove).




He didn't tell everybody. What was their mission? gather information


Go, look over the land," he said, "especially Jericho."



First and strategic location




So they went and entered the house of a prostitute named Rahab and stayed there.

The king of Jericho was told, "Look! Some of the Israelites have come here tonight to spy out the land." So the king of Jericho sent this message to Rahab..




Word gets out: How did they know? – part of test for Rahab

So the king of Jericho sent this message to Rahab.. "Bring out the men who came to you and entered your house, because they have come to spy out the whole land."




Their demand – turn them in! (a choice to make) What time did the guards come?

But the woman had taken the two men and hidden them.




Already prepared?

Flat roof – observable by others?


So the men set out in pursuit of the spies on the road that leads to the fords of the Jordan, and as soon as the pursuers had gone out, the gate was shut.



Assume they are heading back to camp


Locked in! Do they suspect they are still in the city?

Now then, please swear to me by the LORD that you will show kindness to my family, because I have shown kindness to you.


A binding promise (by the LORD) Plea for others as a return favour

What sign(guarantee) does she want?

"Our lives for your lives!" the men assured her. "If you don't tell what we are doing, we will treat you kindly and faithfully when the LORD gives us the land."




OK if No word! (certainty of outcome – not like previous spies)

So she let them down by a rope through the window, for the house she lived in was part of the city wall.



Gate locked
Outside wall – just by chance? Strong-walled city

Now she had said to them, "Go to the hills so the pursuers will not find you. Hide yourselves there three days until they return, and then go on your way."



Her advice – good (not the expected direction or time) vs. 'Get out as fast as you can'.

If anyone goes outside your house into the street, his blood will be on his own head; we will not be responsible.


It's only your house – inside is our responsibility


We take responsibility for all inside – if ... no talk. agreed. To your terms

So she sent them away and they departed. And she tied the scarlet cord in the window.




Straight away (made sure every day?). Would it raise suspicions?

The plan worked



Hebrews 11:31 By faith the prostitute Rahab, because she welcomed the spies, was not killed with those who were disobedient.


James 2:25 In the same way, was not even Rahab the prostitute considered righteous for what she did when she gave lodging to the spies and sent them off in a different direction?




