

Joshua 22:1-9 Going home at last.




Joshua 22:1-9 Going home at last.


For a long time now-

Trusting his wisdom and love...




The word 'serve' is also used as a term for 'worship'.



An important principle – that David later observed with his men.

1 Samuel 30:23-24 But David said, "You shall not do so, my brothers, with what the LORD has given us. He has preserved us and given into our hand the band that came against us.

... They shall share alike."

So the Reubenites, the Gadites and the half-tribe of Manasseh left the Israelites at Shiloh in Canaan to return to Gilead, their own land, which they had acquired in accordance with the command of the LORD through Moses.

Mark 12:28-34 And one of the scribes came up ... and asked Jesus, "Which commandment is the most important of all?" Jesus answered,

"The most important is, 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one.
