





Here is a hint of a sad note that we see come to pass in the time of the later judges.

Without a real experience of God it leads eventually to even abandoning the outward forms of service.



#### A promise kept

And Joseph's bones, which the Israelites had brought up from Egypt,

Exodus 13:19 Moses took the bones of Joseph with him, for Joseph had made the sons of Israel solemnly swear, saying, "God will surely visit you, and you shall carry up my bones with you from here."



Joseph had died some 4 centuries before. In faith he wanted the land of Israel as his final resting place, believing that God would fulfil his promise about the land.

## Family property


And Joseph's bones, ...were buried at Shechem in the tract of land that Jacob bought for a hundred pieces of silver from the sons of Hamor, the father of Shechem.

Genesis 33:18-20 And Jacob came safely to the city of Shechem, which is in the land of Canaan, on his way from Paddan-aram, and he camped before the city. And from the sons of Hamor, Shechem's father, he bought for a hundred pieces of money the piece of land on which he had pitched his tent. There he erected an altar and called it El-Elohe-Israel.






