

Your mother and brothers are standing outside, wanting to see you.




Why did they come? What was their concern?



What was Jesus' response?




What is the important lesson here? Can we find ourselves under similar pressure?




Jesus got tired!

A squall came down on the lake, so that the boat was being swamped, and they were in great danger.




What woke him up?



Jesus had said, "Let us go." They said, "Master, we're going to drown."


What were they afraid of?

Where did the storm come from? "A squall came down on the lake" – Luke's geography



Where did the storm come from? Jesus "rebuked" the storm – it's a term usually spoken

against someone who can understand.

cf. Job 1:12



In fear and amazement they asked one another, "Who is this? He commands even the winds and the water, and they obey him."

They are really frightened now! A new revelation of who he is:-The Supreme Commander

Note the paradox!
