




As Jesus was on his way, the crowds almost crushed him.




What did it take for him to come to Jesus?

Leviticus 15:25 ..

Mark 5:26 She had suffered a great deal under the care of many doctors and had spent all she had, yet instead of getting better she grew worse.

What did it take for her to come to Jesus?

Num 15:38 ... "Speak to the Israelites and say to them: 'Throughout the generations to come you are to make tassels on the corners of your garments, with a blue cord on each tassel. You will have these tassels to look at and so you will remember all the commands of the LORD.... Then you will remember to obey all my commands and will be consecrated to your God. I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt to be your God. I am the LORD your God."

What does she need now?



What is the difference between the crowd touch and hers?




This is what she needs now

While Jesus was still speaking,




What do you think Jairus was thinking?

Public Announcement


Sorry folks! The funeral is off.
