
The Pharisees and the Experts in the Law

A good idea >> routine >> rule



When Jesus had finished speaking, a Pharisee invited him to eat with him; so he went in and reclined at the table.




Nice to invite Jesus to your home - lunch time Interested to know more/An opportunity to observe?

- be sure of the facts


Jesus lets the light shine on their actions and motives.

Then the Lord said to him, "Now then, you Pharisees clean the outside of the cup and dish, but inside you are full of greed and wickedness. You foolish people! Did not the one who made the outside make the inside also?



Superficially OK but under the surface – rotten God is interested in both – not impressed but just veneer

But now as for what is inside you--be generous to the poor, and everything will be clean for you.






Wrong priorities - do the more visible? less demanding?

Love --- performance and public praise - self problem again


Woe No. 3 for the Pharisees

Experts in the Law also known as the Scribes Job description -- Copy and interpret the scriptures

He recognises the criticisms apply to them too!

3 Woes for the Scribes

Jesus replied, "And you experts in the law,

Woe to you, because you load people down with burdens they can hardly carry, and you yourselves will not lift one finger to help them.

Woe to you, because you build tombs for the prophets, and it was your ancestors who killed them. So you testify that you approve of what your ancestors did; they killed the prophets, and you build their tombs. Because of this, God in his wisdom said, 'I will send them prophets and apostles, some of whom they will kill and others they will persecute.' Therefore this generation will be held responsible for the blood of all the prophets that has been shed since the beginning of the world, from the blood of Abel to the blood of Zechariah, who was killed between the altar and the sanctuary. Yes, I tell you, this generation will be held responsible for it all.

Woe No. 1 for the Scribes

Woe to you, because you load people down with burdens they can hardly carry, and you yourselves will not lift one finger to help them.

Not defending God's word Distorting it, making harder for people with man-made rules



Woe No. 2 for the Scribes

"Woe to you, because you build tombs for the prophets, and it was your ancestors who killed them. So you testify that you approve of what your ancestors did; they killed the prophets, and you build their tombs

Not changed just like their ancestors with same attitude



Woe No. 2 for the Scribes

Because of this, God in his wisdom said, 'I will send them prophets and apostles, some of whom they will kill and others they will persecute.' Therefore this generation will be held responsible for the blood of all the prophets that has been shed since the beginning of the world, from the blood of Abel to the blood of Zechariah, who was killed between the altar and the sanctuary. Yes, I tell you, this generation will be held responsible for it all.

Direct consequences terrible judgement on nation Why for their time? Messiah here!

Woe No. 3 for the Scribes

Woe to you experts in the law, because you have taken away the key to knowledge. You yourselves have not entered, and you have hindered those who were entering.



A Key should open --->> understand and obey

In the dark but resist those who are seeking or have the light.




When Jesus went outside, the Pharisees and the teachers of the law began to oppose him fiercely and to besiege him with questions, waiting to catch him in something he might say.



Give him a hard time ,resistant, arrogant, unteachable See the increasing hostility to Jesus
