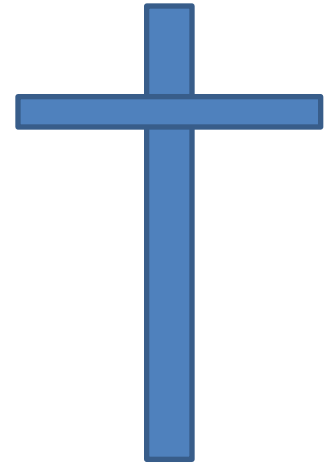

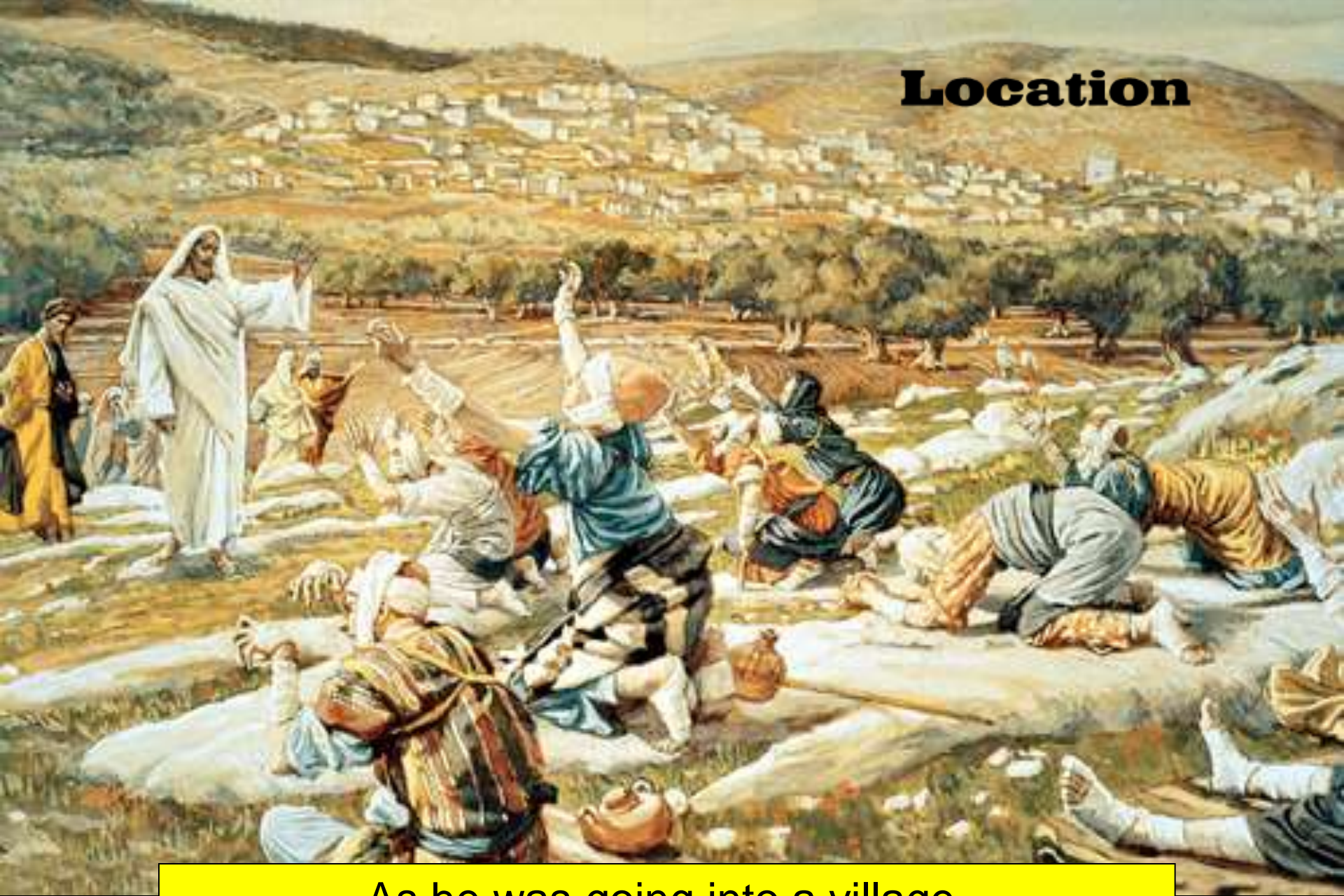


Jesus travelled along

**Honour the bible's teaching**

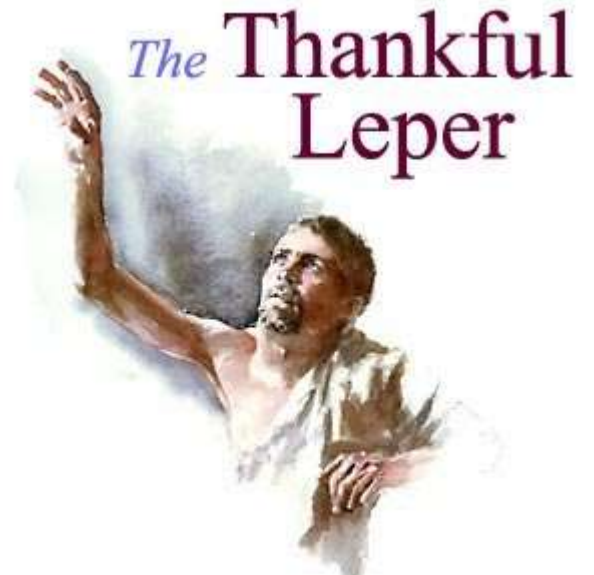
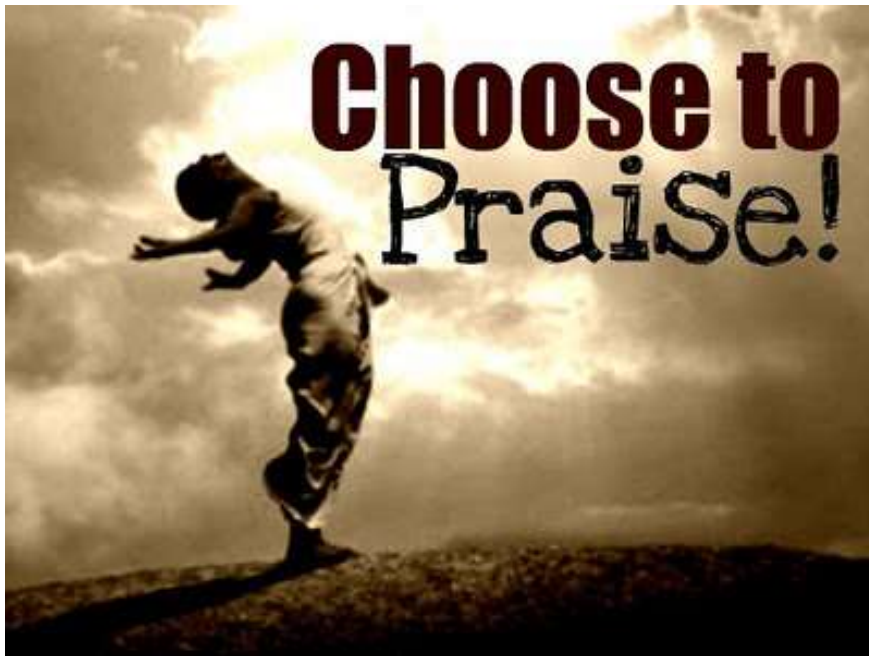
**A Faith challenge**
