

Scattered throughout the world –


This becomes a symbol of the end of this world when God's judgement falls.

Matthew – another occasion on Mount of Olives – tell us again?




Magnificent description, gold decorations, Permanence? Presence ?Security ? – Jeremiah's day 'the Temple of the Lord'




#### When you hear of wars and uprisings, ...

They will hand you over to synagogues and put you in prison, and you will be brought before kings and governors, and all on account of my name.







According to Josephus, the siege of Masada by troops of the Roman Empire at the end of the First Jewish–Roman War ended in the mass suicide of 960 people, the rebels and their families who were hiding there.


## They will fall by the sword and will be taken as prisoners to all the nations.

Josephus speaks of 97,000 Jews sent to various provinces and to the Egyptian mines.


Prophecy

– fulfilled AD 70



About 132–136 AD there was the Bar Kokhba revolt, a rebellion of the Jews of the Roman province of Judea, led by Simon bar Kokhba, against the Romans. It failed. His followers considered him to be the Messiah.

In an attempt to erase any memory of Judea or Ancient Israel, Emperor Hadrian wiped the name off the map and replaced it with Syria Palaestina




## Jerusalem will be trampled on by the Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled.

by the Romans – they wrecked the city and built pagan shrines on temple site.




