


On the first day of the week, very early in the morning,




Sunday begins on Saturday evening!

the women took the spices they had prepared and went to the tomb.




Why did they go if they knew that the tomb was sealed?

They found the stone rolled away from the tomb,




What happened to the guards?

He has risen!


Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee:

'The Son of Man must be delivered over to the hands of sinners, be crucified and on the third day be raised again.'





Death has been defeated.




There's more to living than just this world –
