Philippians 4:4-8



Looking beyond the cross Hebrews 12:2 For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.



Specifics - Tell him!









This is peace given to me from God AND is his kind of peace





He will keep us from sinning or sinking




