



Part 6 Matthew 7:1-12




We try to make sense of what we see, but it can cause problems.

People look at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart. 1 Samuel 16:7

Do not judge.

Social status, Accent, Wealth, Height, Weight, Clothes, Education.

Beware!

Pride, envy and judgmentalism



Do not judge.

Ethnic background

Eg. Hutu & Tutsi

Biologically there is only 1 race The human race

Do not judge, or you too will be judged.

DON'T PUT PEOPLE IN BOXES

For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged. and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.

Beware! What goes round, comes round



Why do you look at the speck of sawdust in your brother`s eye and pay no attention to the plank in your own eye?



How easy it is to see OUR faults in others ! How can you say to your brother, `Let me take the speck out of your eye,` when all the time there is a plank in your own eye?



You can't give what you don't have

You hypocrite, first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother`s eye.





Being judgmental and making judgements are not the same thing



Do not give dogs what is sacred; do not throw your pearls to pigs.

How do you know who are 'dogs and pigs' ? Is that being judgmental? Warnings of fools in Proverbs.







If you do, <u>they</u> may trample them under their feet, and then turn and tear you to pieces.




dog<u>S</u> & pig<u>S</u>

Which of you, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone?






Obvious answer ! It's not a trick.




Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a snake?








If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, <u>how much more</u> will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!
