
Enter through the narrow gate. small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.

Taking the wrong way




In the minority?









For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it.



A mistake here is fatal!

to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills. 1Co. 12:10-11

Know what you believe. Exercise Spirit discernment

Test the fruit

Warning: Double danger!

Paul said .. I know that after I leave, savage wolves will come in among you and will not spare the flock.

Acts 20:29

Jesus said ... "I know your works, your labour, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil. And you have tested those who say they are apostles and are not, and have found them liars;

Nevertheless I have this against you, that you have left your first love. Revelation 2:2,4

By their fruit you will recognize them.



What bad fruit are we to look for ?

Their personal lifestyle, Effects on others ...

Do people pick grapes from thornbushes, or figs from thistles?









An audience familiar with these plants

Likewise every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, and a bad tree cannot bear good fruit

A Crab-apple tree and fruit





The fruit reflects the NATURE of the tree

Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.



Present and future judgement



Thus, by their fruit you will recognize them.

Not everyone who says to me, `Lord, Lord,` will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.

'I never knew you.


Away from me, you evildoers!`


Does Jesus know you?

But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand.






What's the difference at first?

The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash.




Jesus isn't really talking about the weather and houses!

The crowd's response


When Jesus had finished saying these things, the crowds were amazed at his teaching, because he taught as one who had authority, and not as their teachers of the law.



"one who had authority"
This was something new to them

Do you acknowledge his authority
