
Jesus sends the Promised Holy Spirit

John 14:16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever--But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. "When the Advocate comes, whom I will send to you from the Father--the Spirit of truth who goes out from the Father--he will testify about me.



His presence for all, everywhere

John 16:5-7 but now I am going to him who sent me. None of you asks me, 'Where are you going?' Rather, you are filled with grief because I have said these things. But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.



Acts 1:7 -11 He said to them: "It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."




Jesus' victorious return to heaven Psalm 47:5 God has ascended amid shouts of joy, the LORD amid the sounding of trumpets.


Hebrews12:2 fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith.


