


As the old year has gone and the new begun we think of what has past and consider the future.

When did time begin? Was it always there?




Some people suggest a big bang start off a loooooooong time ago.

John 2:10


2. In salvation

Don't let your imagination fool you.


All we have is today.




This is the Lord's promise for today
