

Why not burdensome?

When we realise God knows best

He gives grace and power to live according to His perfect will.

"Take MY YOKE" Matthew 11:29

In contrast the burdens that empty religion puts on people!

For love's sake: Just as the seven years of Jacob's service for Laban seemed only a few days to him because of the love he had for Rachel (Genesis 29:18), so obeying God's commands does not seem a burden when we really love Him.

Whose yoke are you wearing?

This is love for God.. to obey his commands. And his commands are not burdensome, for everyone born of God overcomes the world.

Victory is assured

This is the victory that **has** overcome the world, even our faith.

A living faith is the means of victory because it links us to God's protective power from danger and to his power to defeat the schemes of our enemies.

Faith is such a precious gift that should operate throughout our Christian lives

– not just at the start.



Who is it that overcomes the world? Only he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God.

Just to make it clear It is faith (trust, dependence) in the one and only Saviour Jesus – the Son of God

Overcomers have a special place in the world to come. Jesus promised:-

To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne (Revelation 3:21).

This is the one who came by water and blood--Jesus Christ.





Jesus' came physically into this world to (1) identify with his people and to (2) die for them

He did not come by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth.

He didn't come just to reveal God, but he came to save us.

The Holy Spirit as the Spirit of truth bears witness to Jesus

through the scriptures, in our hearts and by signs and wonders done in Jesus' name.



A 'missing' verse: 1 John 5:7

For there are three that bear record in heaven

If there is one thing that is certain in textual criticism, it is that this famous verse is not genuine. External and internal evidence are alike overwhelmingly against the verse. There are three facts, which every one should know, and which alone are enough to show that the words are an interpolation.

- (1) Verse 7 is not found in a single Greek MS. earlier than the fourteenth century.
- (2) Not one of the Greek or Latin Fathers who conducted the controversies about the doctrine of the Trinity in the third, fourth, and first half of the fifth centuries ever quotes these words.
- (3) The words occur first towards the end of the fifth century in Latin, and are found in no other language until the fourteenth century.


The testimony of God and My Testimony

It is this serious! To reject what God has clearly made known is effectively accusing God of not telling us the truth.


A very foolish and dangerous thing to do.
