
Our faith (believed and then lived out) really matters



Keeping fit? Your body is a gift - the Spirit's temple



"Saviour" is a big word

Set the lead by your life

For believers – don't expect the world to love you – you may be called a crank.


What was Timothy's gift?

and the 'talents' parable




What gifts does God give to believers?
