
Three Kinds of Slavery



1 Timothy 6:1-10

All who are under the yoke of slavery should consider their masters worthy of full respect, so that God's name and our teaching may not be slandered. Those who have believing masters are not to show less respect for them because they are brothers. Instead, they are to serve them even better, because those who benefit from their service are believers, and dear to them. These are the things you are to teach and urge on them. If anyone teaches false doctrines and does not agree to the sound instruction of our Lord Jesus Christ and to godly teaching, he is conceited and understands nothing. He has an unhealthy interest in controversies and quarrels about words that result in envy, strife, malicious talk, evil suspicions and constant friction between men of corrupt mind, who have been robbed of the truth and who think that godliness is a means to financial gain.



All who are under the yoke of slavery




It is estimated that 20 to 30% of Italy's population were slaves! Many slaves became believers – Did they appreciate the blessings?

Treat and regard them with a new attitude.

Treating them with respect is

– a powerful evangelistic tool!

Cf. Peter about harsh masters

1 Peter 4:16 Yet if anyone suffers as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in that name.



They should consider their masters worthy of full respect, so that God's name and our teaching may not be slandered.

Bad attitude and behaviour reflects on the God you claim to worship and discredits the teachings of the faith

People may say,

"If that's Christianity
then I don't want to know!"



Christian bosses

Those who have believing masters are not to show less respect for them because they are brothers.

They are not to take advantage of them because they now see they are equal in God's salvation plan – brothers

There was a cause of right 'offence' when master and slave were seen going together to church meetings.
And some slaves had become elders!



Service

Instead, they are to serve them even better,

The term "serve" changes it from imposed slavery to

willing obedient service.

It's a greater motivation to do better Love is always a great motivator



Instead, they are to serve them even better, because those who benefit from their service are believers, and dear to them.

Why?
Because you are doing good to a fellow believer, and they are 'dear'.




Do you appreciate your brothers?

These are the things you are to teach and urge on them.

Teaching and preaching

These matters are not optional.

Believer's behaviour is changed by 'hearing' the truth.



The test of what is taught.

If anyone teaches false doctrines and does not agree to **the sound instruction of our Lord Jesus Christ and to godly teaching**, he is conceited and understands nothing.

'Sound' teaching should show positive for the following ingredients:-

- *The Lord Jesus Christ
- *Who he is and what he did and what he says
- *Teaching that is right and promotes right behaviour



No. 2 Ego slavery

If anyone teaches false doctrines and does not agree to the sound instruction of our Lord Jesus Christ and to godly teaching, he is conceited and understands nothing.



They have been taken over by their 'hobby horse' ideas. They suffer from proud thinking - 'we are the ones who have got it

all right!'

Their understanding is superficial, so they don't see the implications and practical consequences of their erroneous ideas.



How EGO shows itself

He has an unhealthy interest in controversies and quarrels about words

An "unhealthy interest" means that they are engrossed in and addicted to arguments about "words"

It seems so trivial! What do the 'words' mean?



All truth matters, but some truths are more important than others!

Rotten Fruit

He has an unhealthy interest in controversies and quarrels about words that result in envy, strife, malicious talk, evil suspicions

The fruit of false teaching
Division - cf recent critical theories of culture,
race, gender etc.

A terrible ungodly result!



and constant friction between men of corrupt mind, who have been robbed of the truth

Their minds have been robbed by others 'passing it on'. It poisons and corrupts their thinking. (The enemy is behind it)

False teaching never leads to peace but only to friction



No 3 Slavery of materialism – the love of stuff

and they think that godliness is a means to financial gain.


They have a completely distorted view of godliness.

It is a form of a 'prosperity' teaching.

The primary aim of godliness is not self-interest but a desire for God to be glorified through our lives



But there are real benefits to true godliness



The gains are not material things in themselves although God may work with or without them.

Contentment is the attitude of the heart that is thankful for all of God's mercies, recognising that God knows what we really need and provides for us.

Philippians 4:11 Not that I am speaking of being in need, for I have learned in whatever situation I am, to be content.

If you take the long view, it is obvious.

For we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out of it.



We arrived with nothing.

And nothing of a material nature is going to leave with us.

We cannot keep a hold on it and we cannot take it with us.



Do we have treasures stored in heaven? (Matthew 6:20)

What are the basics that we need to live?

But if we have food(pl) and clothing(pl), we will be content with that.

Natural life needs food and a covering.

What kind/level of food and clothing would you consider as sufficient to make you content?

Are we content with these basics?




Matthew 6:31-33 Therefore do not be anxious, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the Gentiles seek after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them all. But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

They are sadly absorbed with acquisition

Temptation - "just look at that!" **Trap** – once hooked!

It is a form of idolatry and a failure to believe that God is our security and will meet our needs.

It takes you down a dangerous road.


Foolish desires - crazy collections of 'stuff'
Harmful – prepared to go to any
lengths to get what you want



The Result – plunged(sunk and drowned) in ruin morally and often financially and ultimately soul ruin.

For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil.

It really is a heart issue.
(That is why it is idolatry)
It is not **having** money that is the problem.
It's **loving** it. Cf. the rich young ruler -



It is the root cause of:-

Neglect of other people – they are not important

Abuse of others in its pursuit

Fostering envy or pride by comparing ourselves to others

Self destruction

Left the Path

Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

Their desire made them focus on what they considered 'important' to the sad neglect of their spiritual life. That had resulted in their abandoning their faith and giving them trouble in its pointless pursuit.



Materialism has become their cruel master.
