To him be honour and might forever. Amen.

Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share. Turn away from godless chatter and the opposing ideas of what is falsely called knowledge, which some have professed and in so doing have wandered from the faith. Grace be with you.


3 pairs of positive positives -Some things to actively go after.

In trials having a contented spirit




Fight the good fight of the faith.


God's call has entered his life

How?

Recognise the value of this new life Its quality and quantity

'Fight the good fight with all thy might, Christ is thy strength, and Christ thy right; Lay hold on life, and it shall be Thy joy and crown eternally. Run the straight race through God's good grace, Lift up thine eyes and seek His Face; Life with its way before us lies, Christ is the path, and Christ the prize.'

Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called when you made your good confession in the presence of many witnesses.


Paul remembers and may be reminding Timothy of what happened at his baptism.



The ultimate witness

In the sight of God, who gives life to everything, and of Christ Jesus,

This is a serious charge - God sees NOW He is the real life-giver and sustainer The Messiah Jesus is also present as a witness.



Our great example

Christ Jesus,

who while testifying before Pontius Pilate made the good confession

While he was on trial conducted himself in a holy way and declared his Lordship – a good witness



I charge you to keep this command without spot or blame

A solemn charge – do this!

With commitment and integrity so that no one can justly criticise



It's a lifetime thing

I charge you to keep this command without spot or blame until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ,

It applies until Jesus returns – or you go to be with him.

Jesus is coming back in glory

Titus 2:13 waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Saviour Jesus Christ,



It's no good trying to guess

until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ, which God will bring about in his own time-

It is certain that He will return When – is unknown to us but not to God He has his own purposes - not to be rushed or delayed



This is our God

God, the blessed and only Ruler, the King of kings and Lord of lords, who alone is immortal and who lives in unapproachable light, whom no one has seen or can see. To him be honour and might forever. Amen.

Blessed – worthy of praise There is only one ruler in this universe He is still in charge.

This is God's superior place above earthly kings and authorities

This title is also applied to God's Son – Jesus in Revelation 17:14

He is the only one to have life within his being eternally there.

Earthly human eyes are not capable of seeing his glory in its fulness -

He is utterly glorious Jesus said, "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God." Praise rightly belongs to him.

This is not simply a prayer but a declaration of what is true of God forever.

Amen – is the Hebrew 'yes' to Paul's praise-prayer



Back to earth practical considerations ...

A reminder to the rich in the congregation

They may be rich now – but this world is passing and all that belongs to it

Be wise while you have it.

The danger of pride in present prosperous circumstances. Tell them that trust in wealth is not a good idea - things can change so quickly And even if they don't, wealth offers no security at the judgement



This is not an option

The proper source of hope for the future is God – outside of time – but able to help in present needs



God's amazing generosity towards us

Enjoy God's Blessings

We are unworthy – so this calls for gratitude in our enjoyment

What are good deeds? Doing what God commands – instructs – and teaches us Real riches are only found in godly activity

Matthew 5:16, 'let your light shine ... that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father in heaven.

Godly living prepares us for the kingdom. And it also brings us into the blessing of experiencing its qualities now, even before we enter it fully - this is real living




Paul wants for them what he wanted for Timothy

They call their stuff 'knowledge'


but it isn't based on truth
