
Colossians 2:16-23 Freedom in Christ Jesus

Therefore let no one pass judgment on you in questions of food and drink, or with regard to a festival or a new moon or a Sabbath. These are a shadow of the things to come, but the substance belongs to Christ. Let no one disqualify you, insisting on asceticism and worship of angels, going on in detail about visions, puffed up without reason by his sensuous mind, and not holding fast to the Head, from whom the whole body, nourished and knit together through its joints and ligaments, grows with a growth that is from God. If with Christ you died to the elemental spirits of the world, why, as if you were still alive in the world, do you submit to regulations— "Do not handle, Do not taste, Do not touch" (referring to things that all perish as they are used) according to human precepts and teachings? These have indeed an appearance of wisdom in promoting self-made religion and asceticism and severity to the body, but they are of no value in stopping the indulgence of the flesh.

Issues facing the Colossians - with a Jewish flavour

Kosher – teetotal? Festivals Days



These are a shadow of the things to come,

They were temporary expressions of God's will

The point is clear: days and foods, as observed under the Mosaic Law, are not binding upon New Covenant people.

The shadow has passed, the reality has come. So for the Christian, *all* foods are pure (1Timothy 4:4-5) and *all* days belong to God.

Christians are therefore free to keep a kosher diet or to observe the sabbath if they please. There is nothing wrong with those things. However, they cannot think that eating kosher or sabbath observance makes them any closer to God, and they cannot **judge** another brother or sister who does not observe such laws.

These are a shadow of the things to come, but the substance belongs to Christ.

Shadow versus 'solid'

Fulfilled in Christ – your answer to 'judgement' by others

Feed on him

Celebrate his works and person

Live each day for him.

Enter his 'rest'.



Let no one disqualify you, insisting on asceticism and worship of angels,

-divert from your course to rob you of your prize
They insist on 'something more'
Asceticism –false humility- a kind of monastic development?
It is a negative view of life


Angelic mediators with God via material (sinful) world. Worship only God. We have direct access through Jesus. They are forms of idolatry.

1 Timothy 6:17 As for the rich in this present age, charge them not to be haughty, nor to set their hopes on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who richly provides us with everything to enjoy.

going on in detail about visions, puffed up without reason by his sensuous mind,

This shows evidence of pride "My experience – visions" With an inflated sense of importance It is sensuous(and human in origin) rather than spiritual.


We don't need to take on board these ideas.

In character, actions words and deeds, thoughts Helping others to develop in the faith Numerical growth – more people saved


This God at work in us.

Examples of their rules No dealings with ...

Don't eat ...

Don't touch as if contaminated by them...



So how do we 'apply' the OT scripture teachings in the New Covenant life? Cf 1 Peter 1:14-16

As obedient children, do not be conformed to the passions of your former ignorance, but as he who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, since it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy."

(referring to things that all perish as they are used)

2 Corinthians 4:18 as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal.

Cf Isaiah's rebuke
Jesus with the Pharisees.
Rabbinic claims of 'traditions of the elders' oral law.
Going beyond and undermining God's word.

Isaiah 29:13 And the Lord said: "Because this people draw near with their mouth and honour me with their lips, while their hearts are far from me, and their fear of me is a commandment taught by men,



These have indeed an appearance of wisdom

The ideas seem to make sense and look good but deception only works when there are some similarities



in promoting self-made religion

The result of these additions make a new religion (rule based) and human in origin



Cf the Baal prophets

1 Kings 18:27-28 And at noon Elijah mocked them, saying, "Cry aloud, for he is a god. Either he is musing, or he is relieving himself, or he is on a journey, or perhaps he is asleep and must be awakened." And they cried aloud and cut themselves after their custom with swords and lances, until the blood gushed out upon them.

The rituals etc. don't work.

Sin isn't to be dealt with in this way

It only promotes pride, judgementalism, and feeds sin



Romans 8:13
For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live.
