Therefore, brothers, since we have **confidence** to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, v19


A different approach is possible with Jesus We enter the heavenly tabernacle with sacrificial blood of our Saviour (Jesus – this is a reference to his humanity)

He uses the Tabernacle parallel —> curtain = his body. Both were torn.




and since we have a great(High) priest over the house of God, v21

It means a transformed lifestyle, a godly way of life. We are saved from the guilt, pollution, and power of sin




Encouragement

Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. v23


"Let us" – together! The importance of fellowship

Now is an important time .. The Day (of his coming as our deliverer)




He gives a stern warning of the consequences of turning away It is not a light choice you are considering.



A reminder: God will settle all debts

God deals with his people too!


What a terrible prospect to have God as your enemy "Living" – God is active now and there is no final escape

Remember those earlier days after you had received the light, when you stood your ground in a great contest in the face of suffering. v32

The good old days!

It wasn't easy being a disciple of Jesus then.

But you held true to your convictions



Sometimes you were publicly exposed to insult and persecution; at other times you stood side by side with those who were so treated. v33

The world's appalling treatment of believers

"insult and persecution" - verbal and physical

Fellowship support – you were prepared to stand with them



Matthew 5:11-12 "Blessed are you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

You sympathized with those in prison and joyfully accepted the confiscation of your property, because you knew that you yourselves had better and lasting possessions. v34

They helped imprisoned believers


They had been robbed – by mobs and by 'official' theft



Their real treasures are in heaven and the future earth

So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded. v35

Hold on! Great blessings are ultimately in store.



You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised. v36

The one and only road to success

Trust – obey – (keep on repeating) - reward



For in just a very little while, "He who is coming will come and will not delay. v37

This is a quote from Habakkuk 2:3-4

The Lord's coming is certain and will not be delayed, but his timing is perfect.

How short is "a very little while"?



For in just a very little while, "He who is coming will come and will not delay. **But my righteous one will live by faith**. v37-38

Believers have to 'believe'. It's about **living** by faith

"Will live" can be taken as a promise

Each believer has been received as a righteous person belonging to HIM.



God doesn't want you to turn back

For in just a very little while, "He who is coming will come and will not delay. But my righteous one will live by faith. And if he shrinks back, I will not be pleased with him." v37-38

Your response is Your responsibility.



But we are not of those who shrink back and are destroyed, but of those who believe and are saved. v39

Choose the right way.

"We" means you are included if you really believe.

Persevere and we cannot be ultimately lost.

Such people believe (trust) and are saved (his doing!)
